He is the author of *Excavating Modernity: The Roman Past in Fascist Italy* (Cornell, 2012) and *Forty-Five Days: The Fall of Mussolini and Italy's Reckoning with Fascism* (Oxford, 2027); he was also co-PI on the multimedia project *Authoritarianism: Lives, Legacies, Traumas* (2023). His research has been supported by the American Academy in Rome, the Mellon Foundation, the Wolfsonian, and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada.
